Men's & Women's

- All players are required to be vaccinated in order to participate. It is the captain's responsibility to make sure that players are vaccinated.
- Masks and social distancing encouraged for spectators and players on the sidelines.
- Primary exposure (player tests COVID+) will require a negative COVID PCR test to come back to play OR sit out for 10 days.
- Secondary exposures (close contact) who are not fully vaccinated will require a negative COVID PCR to come back to play OR sit out for 10 days from the day of contact.
- Secondary exposures (close contact) who are fully vaccinated are required to wear a mask when on the field, for 10 days from the day of contact.
- It is the captain's responsibility to inform the opposing team, umpire and ARCL about the +ve or close contact instance from their team asap.
- It is the captain's responsibility to follow up with the opposing team, umpire and ARCL with the test results atleast 1 day before the player participates in a game.
- Travel outside of state will require a 5-day quarantine or a PCR-based COVID test to return to play.

Youth

- Vaccination is highly recommended for all eligible players.
- Masks are highly encouraged for unvaccinated players.
- Masks and social distancing encouraged for spectators and players on the sidelines.
- Primary exposure (player tests COVID+) will require a negative COVID PCR test to come back to play or sit out for 10 days.
- Secondary exposures (close contact) who are not fully vaccinated will require a negative COVID PCR to come back to play OR sit out for 10 days from the day of contact.
- Secondary exposures (close contact) who are fully vaccinated are required to wear a mask when on the field, for 10 days from the day of contact.
- It is the team manager's responsibility to inform the opposing team, umpire and ARCL about the +ve or close contact instance from their team asap.
- It is the team manager's responsibility to follow up with the opposing team, umpire and ARCL with the test results atleast 1 day before the player participates in a game.
- Travel outside of state will require a 5-day quarantine or a PCR-based COVID test to return to play.
